



## **WNC-related Redistricting Commissions**

Every ten years, following the federal census, various governmental entities must re-draw the boundaries of all public officials elected by the vote of citizens with a designated district. To comply with this legal requirement and to reflect the most updated population counts, the state, county, city and school district have specific commissions focused on their respective 'redistricting.'

By clicking on the link below for the appropriate redistricting commission, one can sign-up for regular email updates, review outreach materials and public hearing schedules, understand the decision-making process, and find out how to provide input (either by email or by "attending" a virtual meeting).

Many people voice concerns they may have with current districts (or representatives), or how they want to be grouped with like-minded citizens/communities moving forward, or advocate specific district boundaries, and some point out other factors they believe the commissions also should consider. WNC-related homeowner associations are contributing input to the commissions reflecting their homeowners' interests, and WNC will be providing formal comments as well. Individual opinions are welcome too!
