The present contract to maintain city public toilets with JC Deaux expires next month. The city transitions includes:

1. Instruct the City Administrative Officer (CAO) to identify \$2,185,030 in funding for the six-month temporary toilet transition plan.
2. Instruct StreetsLA, in consultation with relevant departments, to select a permanent toilet to replace the temporary toilets at the 14 sites

The WNC opposes CF21-0979.

WNC moves to extend the current contract with Outfront/JCDeaux so appropriate outreach can be done to explain the criteria and rationale for section to be made.
