2. WNC MOTIONS:

Motion:

The WNC supports Los Angeles City Council File 22-0004 that “the members of the Los Angeles City Council, call for the immediate resignations of Councilmember Kevin De León, and Councilmember Gil Cedillo.”

Motion:

The WNC supports Los Angeles City Council Motions 22-1198, 22-1199, and 22-1201 to remove, Kevin De León, and Gil Cedillo from their leadership positions on City Council committees at the soonest opportunity.

Motion:

The WNC supports Los Angeles City Council Motion contained in City Council File 22-1193 to “hold an election, pursuant to Council Rule 3, to fill the office of Council President in order to replace the previously elected President who has resigned from that office.”

Motion:

The WNC supports Los Angeles City Council Motion contained in City Council File 22-1196 that “the City Council instruct the Chief Legislative Analyst, with the assistance of the City Attorney, to report on the steps needed to place a charter reform ballot initiative before the voters of Los Angeles in 2024, with recommendations that ensure representation is fixed to population growth, in order to increase the number of Los Angeles City Council seats; and, that the City Council instruct the Chief Legislative Analyst, with the assistance of the City Administrative Officer, to prepare a report that outlines and sets forth an immediate redistricting process to implement the updated reforms, after passage of the above-mentioned charter reform ballot initiative.” We believe that the process of drafting a charter reform expanding the City Council demands the involvement of all Angelinos and ask that the report on the steps needed include a section on formalizing the role of the public.

Motion:

The WNC supports an independent investigation into the LA City Council redistricting process.

3. GENERAL PUBLIC COMMENT ON NON-AGENDA ITEMS:

Comments from the public on other matters not appearing on the agenda that are within the Board’s jurisdiction will be heard during the General Public Comment period. Please note that under the Brown Act, the Board is prevented from acting on a matter that you bring to its attention during the General Public Comment period; however, the issue raised by a member of the public may become the subject of a future Board meeting. Public comment is limited to **1 minutes per speaker**, unless adjusted by the presiding officer of the Board.

4. ADJOURNMENT:

In the interest of time, we will limit questions and comments in response to a government official's report to 30 seconds, and we will limit questions and comments in response to motions to 1 minute. Please understand that this is to simply move the meeting along. If a person goes beyond those limits, they will be muted, or the Chair will direct the person that is speaking to stop.

If you are compensated to monitor, attend, or speak at this meeting, City law may require you to register as a lobbyist and report your activity. See Los Angeles Municipal Code §§ 48.01 et seq. More information is available at ethics.lacity.org/lobbying.

Time allocations for agenda items are approximate and may be shortened or lengthened at the discretion of the Chairperson.

The public is requested dial *9, when prompted by the presiding officer, to address the Board on any agenda item before the Board takes an action on an item. Comments from the public on Agenda items will be heard only when the respective item is being considered. Comments from the public on other matters not appearing on the agenda that is within the Board’s subject matter jurisdiction will be heard during the Public Comment period. Public comment is limited to 2 minutes per speaker, unless waived by the Board. Please note that under the Brown Act, the Board is prevented from acting on a matter that you bring to its attention during the General Public Comment period; however, the issue raised by a member of the public may become the subject of a future Board meeting.
